So we have developed some workshops where students can learn that language as well, but in a fun way and with the ability to use an industrial robot and vision system."

The school has received support from local business and FANUC Partner RCN to install and prepare the robot for its use as an education robot. In the future we will see many more companies follow this example, as companies try to secure their future workforce with the skills they require.
